Over a six year period, ceramic artist Lotte Glob journeyed from her workshop near Cape Wrath to 111 lochans around the Scottish Highlands, launching three ceramic stones into each lochan. Each visit was photographed and a journal kept.

Some walks were in the height of summer. At other times Lotte was battered by autumn gales or confronted by winter's icy mantle. At one point she was dive-bombed by skuas. All the time she is accompanied by the sounds and sights of the Highlands.

Floating Stones selects 33 of the lochan visits. Each is recorded in this beautifully produced, large cloth-bound art book with evocative photographs, journal entries and sketches.



Limited Edition Sets of Floating Stones

In the floating stones project, Lotte Glob launched three stones into 111 lochans.

Publication of the book will be marked by a special installation at The Watermill Gallery of 333 floating stones. These will be presented in groups of three, set in heather, within a limited edition of 111 wooden boxes, which will be numbered and signed by Lotte Glob.

There will be a unique opportunity to acquire a part of this installation by buying a set of stones.
